 - **Green Healthy Homes:** Chris Read the Sustainability Manager at the City of SLO will discuss the city's initiatives to promote cleaner, safer, and more resilient housing. The Green Healthy Homes project aims to offer free upgrades to residents in the City of San Luis Obispo residing in Manufactured Housing looking to upgrade to Heat Pump technology. He'll explain what is covered and how we seek to provide more resources to this previously ignored sector of housing in the City of SLO.
 - **Weatherization & Energy Assistance:** Jim McNamara, the Energy Service Director with Community Action Partnership San Luis Obispo, will outline the essential weatherization services and utility assistance programs available to the community—ensuring that lower-income households and seniors can access energy-saving upgrades at little to no cost.
